1. Course fees must be paid prior to visa application for non-EU students except where the visa authorities allow otherwise.
 2. These fees are fixed at the most economic price possible. No negotiation of fees will be entertained.
 3. Course fees must be discharged by SWIFT Transfer which will be supplied in the provisional offer letter to non-EU students . For security reasons, no cash can be accepted.
 4. Course fees are not refundable .
 5. Course commencement and start date is dependent on a viable cohort formation.
 6. Course fees quoted are for the academic year 2007 / 2008 only. Course fees in future years are subject to price reviews.
 7. Griffith College Cork reserves the right to change any of the details or regulations on its web-site or in any brochure or any printed material.
 8. Currency payments are translated into Euros and credited to students at the rate applicable on the date remittance is processed through the College's bank account.
 9. Students classified for fee purposes as non-EU, will not be permitted to change their fee status following admission.
 10. Students may be transferred to its Dublin campus to complete any portion of the programme, at the discretion of the College.
 - 11 The fees quoted for the MSc programme above do not include examination fees of €100 per semester and registration fees of €100 per semester
 13. If a student has to repeat a semester or subjects of a semester, then the student will be billed according to the regulations that will come into force at the start of the 2007/2008 academic term.
 14. All students for whom English is not their first language will be required to sit an English language test prior to the commencement of their course. Students whose level of English does not meet the required standard may be redirected onto a Pre-University course in Griffith College. There is no charge for this. However, for each additional three months required, there will be a charge of €1500. This fee is separate to fees secured already.
 - 15 The payment schedule for the MSc Programme is as follows Year 1 €6,500 and Year 2 €4,500
 16. Course fees include a charge for Medical Insurance (approved by the College) which is required by the Irish Government and visa regulations.
 - 17 Changing Course: You will not be permitted to change your course on your arrival in the College. The course indicated on your offer letter is the course that you must follow.
- In addition, by accepting Griffith College's invitation to register, you acknowledge that Griffith College has made arrangements to provide the services necessary to support you in completing your course and you undertake that you will not, during the period of your Griffith College course, apply for or undertake any course of study in Ireland inconsistent with your participation on your Griffith College course.
